We can see Jack the ripper:

It was an unidentified serial killer generally believed to have been active in the largely improverished areas and around the White Chapel district of London in 1888.



Sweeny Todd:

it's a fictionnal character who first appeared as the vilain of the Victorian penny dreadful series The String of Pearls 1846





And Bloody Mary:

She was the Queen of England and Ireland from July 1553 until her death.



She is best known for her aggressive attemps to reverse the English Reformation.

The course lasts one hour but the museum is not recommended to children under 12 because scenes can shock them.
